SUBJECT TITLE: Leela Reserve Subdivision Phase 1 - Final Plat (Community Development)

OBJECTIVE:

To approve the Final Plat for Leela Reserve Phase 1 Located South of Slim Haywood Ave., West of Shanti Niketan Blvd.

SUMMARY:

Leela Reserve Phase 1 is a proposed residential subdivision located south of Slim Haywood Avenue, west of Shanti Niketan Boulevard. The subject property is approximately 23 acres in size, and the proposed Final Plat subdivides the land into 69 lots for the construction of single family dwellings as permitted under the existing Residential Multi-Family (RMF-2) zoning approved by City Council on August 21, 2019. The Preliminary Plat for this subdivision was approved by City Council on July 21, 2021. Leela Reserve Phase 1 is included as part of a Community Development District approved by City Council on September 21, 2022. City staff has reviewed the Final Plat and determined that adopted levels of service for all regulated public facilities will be provided. This Final Plat document meets the requirements of the City of Tavares Land Development Regulations and Comprehensive Plan.

SUBJECT TITLE: Request Council's Approval of Equipment for Auction (Finance)

OBJECTIVE:

To request City Council Authorization to dispose by on-line auction vehicles and equipment that have become obsolete and that have reached their useful life.

SUMMARY:

The City currently has seven vehicles, one garbage truck, three mowers, one boat with related equipment, and various other miscellaneous equipment items that have been identified as surplus property. These items have also been identified for disposal due to age, wear and tear, non-performance, cost of repair, or are obsolete for use. The vehicles and equipment are currently stored at the Caroline Water Plant Property.

Florida statutes section 274.07 states that authority for disposal of property shall be recorded in the minutes of the governmental unit. A list of items for auction approval is attached. The list identifies 34 items for auction.

These items (list attached) are currently stored at the Caroline water plant. Upon approval by the City Council, an online auction utilizing Royal Auction Group, Inc. will be conducted, and the proceeds will be deposited into the appropriate fund for the related item. The City will piggy-back on the Collier County Royal Auction Group Contract, Contract Number 18-7262 for auction services.

This process generally realizes 110% of the blue book value for used vehicles.

SUBJECT TITLE: Resolution 2023-02 - Dedication of Janes Way Right-of-Way (Community Development)

OBJECTIVE:

To approve the dedication of 0.70 acres of property as Janes Way right-of-way.

SUMMARY:

On October 20, 2022, a Quit Claim Deed was recorded in Lake County Public Records conveying approximately 0.70 acres of property to the City of Tavares for the purpose of having the property eventually dedicated as right-of-way and serving as the newly constructed entrance for Seasons at Lakeside Forest subdivision. Resolution 2023-02 proposes that the subject property be dedicated for the perpetual use of the public and designated as Janes Way. The subject property shall serve as the main entrance from State Road 19 to the Seasons at Lakeside Forest subdivision currently being constructed west of State Road 19. The dedication of the subject property as Janes Way is in conjunction with City Council's consideration of the approval of the Final Plat for Seasons at Lakeside Forest. The Preliminary Plat for this subdivision was approved by City Council on February 3, 2021. Improvements to Janes Way shall meet the roadway construction standards per the City of Tavares Construction Specifications Manual. Improvements to Janes Way shall be inspected by the City of Tavares prior to acceptance as a City road and bonded for a period of two (2) years from the date of the issuance of a Certificate of Completion.

OPTIONS:

1. City Council approves the dedication of 0.70 acres of property as Janes Way right-of-way.

RESOLUTION 2023-02

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAVARES, FLORIDA, DEDICATING CERTAIN CITY OWNED PROPERTY AS A PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY; SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TAVARES COUNCIL; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Tavares owns fee simple title to the land described in Exhibit “A”;
and

WHEREAS, the City of Tavares desires to dedicate the property described in Exhibit “A”
to the perpetual use of the public; and

WHEREAS, the dedicated property shall be Public Right of Way known as Janes Way;
and

WHEREAS, any improvement to Janes Way shall be constructed to meet roadway
construction standards per the City of Tavares Construction Specifications Manual; and

WHEREAS, all improvements to Janes Way shall be inspected by the City of Tavares
prior to acceptance and bonded for a period of two (2) years from the date of issuance of a
Certificate of Completion issued by the City of Tavares; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tavares, Florida is capable of maintaining and regulating the
proposed right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the dedication of said property is consistent with the transportation and
mobility goals, objectives, and policies of the City’s Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tavares, Florida, deems it in the best interest of
the City to dedicate said property as Public Right of Way; and

WHEREAS, under Section 95.361 of the Florida Statutes, the Mayor and Clerk of the City of Tavares may certify a map showing the lands where this road is located and then said map may be filed in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Lake County; and

WHEREAS, a State licensed land surveyor has prepared a map and legal description of the Janes Way Right-of-Way;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Tavares, Florida as follows:

1. That Janes Way, as described and mapped in "Exhibit A" attached to this resolution, is hereby dedicated as a Public Right of Way by the City of Tavares.
2. That this resolution and attached exhibit shall be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Lake County.

This Resolution will become effective upon approval by the Tavares City Council.

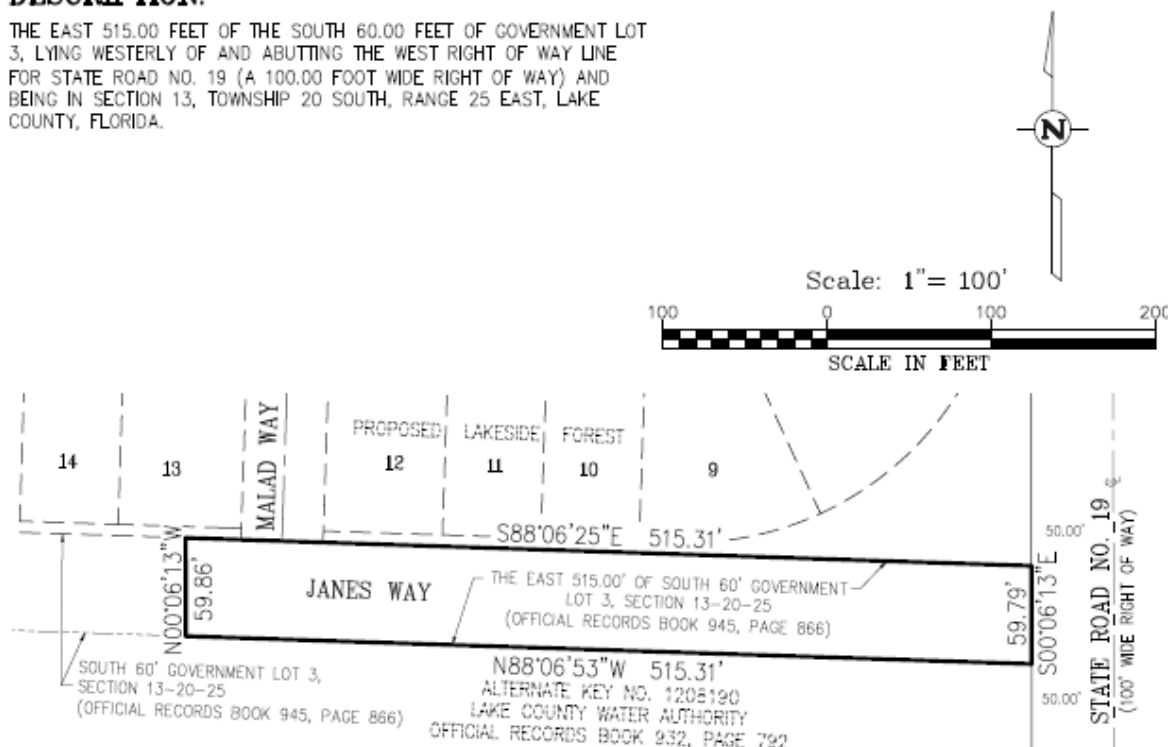

OBJECTIVE:

For Council to receive potential revisions presented by Cagan Management and G3 Development for RFP#2022-14, for the purchase and redevelopment of Tavares Square and for council to make a selection from among the two, one firm for staff to negotiate a purchase and sale agreement to come back to council for final approval.

SUMMARY:

At the City Council meeting of January 18th, Council received proposals and presentations from Cagan Management and G3 Development for RFP#2022-14, the purchase and redevelopment of Tavares Square. After review and discussion on this item, Council determined that additional information should be provided by the two (2) proposers as to what the Council is seeking, and moved to continue the item to the next meeting for further discussion as to what information would be needed to make a decision to award the project to one of the firms for contract negotiations.

At the following Council meeting of February 1, 2023, the board further reviewed and discussed the proposals and provided further input for the proposers to consider in terms of architectural features, parking, building orientation, and related development features. Council voted to give the two firms, Cagan Management, and G3 Development, an opportunity to fine-tune and resubmit their proposals and present any revisions they may choose, based on this input, at the next Council meeting.

OPTIONS:

1. For Council to receive any revisions presented by each of the two proposers, Cagan Management & G3 Development and choose one (1) of the two firms for staff to negotiate a purchase & sales agreement to be brought back to Council when negotiations are completed for consideration.
2. For Council to provide further guidance to the proposers for further revisions to their proposals to be re-considered at a future council meeting.
3. For Council to reject all proposals and start over again.

SUBJECT TITLE: Special Events FY23 Budget Adjustment (Economic Development)

OBJECTIVE:

Request for Council to approve adjusting the FY 23 TIF fund special events budget to re-allocate funds from a previously sponsored non-city event which no longer is in existence.

SUMMARY:

The adopted FY2023 budget includes an allocation of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) in the Community Redevelopment (CRA) TIF fund for City sponsorship of Hydro-Drag Jet Ski Races. The City has been informed by the owner of H2X Racing Promotions, the event operator, that he has retired from the business of jet ski event promotions and operations and will no longer be conducting these jet ski races.

An opportunity exists to enhance the entertainment offerings for this year's City Organized Planes, Tunes & Barbecue (PTB) event which will be taking place March 10-11 at our outdoor events venue at Pontoon Promenade. This ten thousand dollar (\$10,000) re-allocation to PTB, will allow for the potential addition of an exciting new event element of a night time show of hundreds of lighted, synchronized drones, which will be a first for Lake County in our City of Firsts.

OPTIONS:

1. Move to approve the re-allocation of \$10,000 within the current, approve CRA TIF budget to enhance the Planes, Tunes & Barbecue event budget allocation.
2. Do not move to approve the re-allocation of \$10,000 within the current, approve CRA TIF budget to enhance the Planes, Tunes & Barbecue event budget allocati

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Option # 1 is recommended

FISCAL IMPACT:
